2009 Annual \$ 900.00 bursary for graduating students living in
Cramahe Township

Criteria:

1. The student must be graduating from a Secondary School and going on to full time attendance at a post secondary institution or apprenticeship.
2. The student must have a principal residence within the municipality of Cramahe
3. The student must demonstrate economic need for bursary funding.
4. Each Student applicant must provide / meet / demonstrate the following for the Colborne Rotary Club.

Bursary qualification criteria

Marks	30
Financial Need	24
Letter (student created)	15 - work experience, career goals
Volunteer work	20 - beyond 40 hour requirement
Work experience	<u>11</u>

Procedure:

- (a) Student downloads the application from the CDCI West web-site or obtains an application form from his / her School Guidance Department.
- (b) The student completes the forms and returns them to School Guidance Department along with their resume and letter outlining why they qualify. The letter must outline volunteer work, work experience, career goals and be submitted to the school by May, 29, 2009 - parents must also sign the letter.
- (c) Student's home school guidance department will rank the applications, one being the most needy and deserving.
- (d) All applications will be collected by the Colborne Rotary Club - June 5/09
- (e) One bursary will be awarded each year among the four secondary schools.

- (f) Applicants must submit a marks transcript and a copy of their latest report card.
- (g) All decisions of the Rotary Club's bursary committee will be completely confidential and final.
- (h) All applications become the property of the Colborne Rotary Club.
- (i) If no student qualifies the bursary may be carried forward to be offered the following year when two bursaries of \$ 900.00 may be available.
- (j) Thank you to all applicants and school staff and departments.
- (k) The winning applicant will receive a cheque made payable to the post secondary institution they plan to attend.
