How do I get to EBSCO?

- < GO TO <http://search.epnet.com>
- < ENTER User ID: *****
Password: *****
- < CLICK ON Login

Which database do I choose?

Follow the “TIP” directions on the screen to choose one or more databases. Click on the <ENTER> button.

How do I perform a search?

- < **Keyword searching:** Use keywords about your topic.
 - T Use **AND** so that your search results use all your words. For example, type *travel and europe* to find articles that contain both “travel” and “Europe.”
 - T Use **OR** so that your search results contain at least one of the terms. For example, type *college or university* to find articles that contain either “college” or “university”.
- < **Full Text:** checkmark the full text box to limit your results to articles that have the full text (entire magazine article).
- < **Publication:** you can search a specific magazine. Use the “**browse a list of magazines and journals**” icon at the top of screen to enter the magazine title exactly.

How do I use the “Result List”?

- < A keyword search displays the most recent articles first. Go to the next pages to see other articles that may be more useful.
- < Click on the article title to look at the article. To print the article, click “**Print:** Click here to mark for print.”
- < To print more than one article, **Mark** the selected article(s) on the **Result List**.

How do I print or email an article(s)?

- < Click on the **print/email/save** icon.
- < Answer the questions on the screen. **Hint:** Print *only* the articles you need, not the entire list.
- < Click on the **Submit** button at the bottom left hand of the screen.



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
